
What do the different Easter Symbols mean?



The story of the Easter Bunny is thought to have become common in the 19th Century.

Rabbits usually give birth to a big litter of babies (called kittens), so they became a symbol of new life.

Legend has it that the Easter Bunny lays, decorates and hides eggs as they are also a symbol of new life.



The cross represents how Jesus conquered death and was resurrected to new life.

It also represents God's forgiveness of all our sins because Jesus took them all with him in death.



Chocolate eggs are delicious but are an important Easter symbol in Christianity.

They represent new life and rebirth. So people have eggs because it's a metaphor for the resurrection of Jesus Christ and him rolling the stone away from the tomb.

The Easter Story



Jesus arrived in Jerusalem on Palm Sunday. The people were happy to see Jesus and waved palm branches.

Then Jesus went to pray in the garden of Gethsemane.




Judas told the important people where Jesus was. Jesus was arrested.



Peter followed Jesus and waited outside where he was being held. Someone asked if he was Jesus' friend. Peter said he didn't know Jesus.




Then the cock crowed. Peter remembered what Jesus had said and felt very sad.




Pontius Pilate set Barabbas free instead of Jesus. The crowd wanted Jesus punished.

Jesus' body was put into a tomb. A large, heavy stone was put in front of the entrance.



We have also been drawing rainbows and have left a thank you message for all the key workers on our garden wall."




Darcie has made a very colourful butterfly! Amazing.

They would feel happy and supported.





Done his ttrs and the classroom secrets and made cookies too"








Alfie has been up to loads of amazing activities. Well done Alfie!!







Riley has worked hard on his shapes and sounds. He has also helped to measure out and make some Easter Basket cakes!



Corfe Castle


Bella it's great to see that, though you found it hard, you persevered and made a beautiful piece of work. Well done!!



Congratulations on the great news Ben! You must be so excited!




Elliot and Imogen have been doing lots of different Easter crafts. Well done!!
